264/10	<b>Adjournment: (i) Questions from Members of the Public</b>	Resident close to the property Woodside, Guildford Road, Loxwood raised concerns over the length of time taken to redevelop site. They mentioned a petition. Cllr Sanderson suggested they send it to CDC and cc in PC. The PC will contact CDC re same. Cllr Andrews to discuss with Andrew Tyrie to suggest CDC also cc the PC on all responses/correspondence.  Mr L Milsom reminded those present of the Loxwood fair on 5 <sup>th</sup> June. He mentioned a new focussed committee. Cllr Sanderson pointed out that an event at Dunsfold was already being advertised for the same weekend, Fair committee might want to bring their publicity forward?

Cllr Duncton is awaiting a response from his Waverley contact Maureen Woodhill. Speed restrictions across border – Cllr Duncton to keep on top of Surrey/Waverly. Drains Spy Lane sewerage overflow is part of the old system of water/sewerage disposal. Drains now venting into waste land at the end of a garden off Spy Lane. School Governor for Loxwood School is still needed. Loxwood School did well in Travelwise competition. Cllr Duncton suggested CDC may bring in kerbside collection as do most other councils.</p> <p><b>(vii) WW</b> team from WACT on site 12.5.10. Graham Moore to meet. Cllr Sanderson to visit later.</p>
270/10	<b>Planning</b>	<p><b>Southland Lock</b>  No objection to actual plans but comments to add:  Concern of possible bridleway closure (how long)  Unhappy about need to widen towpath and increase strength of surface.  Most concerned about starting work before parapets at B2133 finished.  Number of trees that will have to be felled.  If towpath used, will not be any replacement of trees along full length for yet more years.</p> <p><b>Hurst Cottage</b>  No objection provided the neighbour is happy with the scale of the development.</p> <p><b>Footpath</b> – Official notification of change of route near to Oakhurst.</p> <p><b>Sheaves</b> – The proposed change of land use seemed to be in Waverly, not sure whether we had been sent the application as a courtesy or whether we should comment.</p> <p><b>Treetops</b> - discuss at next meeting (June 2010).</p>
