# 'Mighty Oaks from Little Acorns Grow' From small beginnings great things can happen!

A milk bottle top! Not very significant on its own, other than, because it is plastic, we should not put it into the dustbin to go into landfill! However, one milk bottle top, joined with hundreds of others can be granulated and then turned into playground slides and garden toys as well as more bottle tops!

However, this is only part of the story. There is an even greater benefit to saving and collecting our plastic milk bottle tops. We can make life better for children who have illnesses that shorten their lives, cancer being just one. A recycling company donates to Chestnut Trees in exchange for these milk bottle tops.

So what is the cost to us? Nothing, other than a small effort to wash the tops clean, removing any foil or rubber inserts and save them. We would ask you to drop your collection off at either of our two churches when passing, or at a Sunday service. Bins for this purpose are available at the back of the church at Loxwood and just inside the door at Alfold. Alternatively, there is a collection box on the doorstep of 5 Farm Close, so drop the tops off en route to the Doctors Surgery or the Pub!

Please note: No other types of plastic tops are acceptable; the recyclers will reject the consignment if it is contaminated with other tops.

#### And now we have a sapling!

Thanks to all those who have been collecting tops, we have sent a further 10kg for recycling, making a total of 30kg so far. That's the equivalent of over 19,000 bottles of milk!

#### Mighty oaks from little acorns grow: Sprouting Acorns

#### I. Cranleigh Foodbank

Prior to the lockdowns of the current COVID regulations, we had been supporting the Cranleigh Foodbank. The need for the foodbank has increased; therefore, we are determined to collect regularly at our two churches for Cranleigh Foodbank. Space for storage of items is limited at the Foodbank, therefore, in consultation with the foodbank organisers, we have agreed that, as far as possible, we will try to supply the specific items that they currently require, which are:

Tinned fruit, tinned vegetables, sugar, pasta sauce
UHT milk, tinned tomatoes, tea, coffee, jam, desserts,
and baby wipes!

Please consider adding one item for the foodbank to your shopping basket, whether it be online or in person. Just imagine how many items we could collect if everyone reading this article was able to contribute!

A collection box will be available in each church for donations. Items collected will be taken to the foodbank on a regular basis.



In common with everyone else in the country, we are looking forward so much to be able to resume "normal" service this month and getting back into church – it's been a long time! So, we will be celebrating the return to the church on Sunday 27th June.

#### Knit and Natter - Every Thursday Starting 24th June 1pm-4pm

It does what it says on the can! A very informal meeting in a convivial café-style environment to meet old friends and hopefully make a few more. You don't even have to bring your knitting (it can be any craft or nothing at all) but do drop in at any time for a chat, cake and a cuppa. The perfect ingredients all wrapped in a warm welcome that awaits you!

#### Alfold Parish Council

Alfold Parish Council convened via Zoom on  $8^{th}$  April 2021 to discuss current planning applications, Loxley Oil Well, as well as Alfold's Neighbourhood Plan.

Councillors discussed new applications for increasing houses on the current application site at Alfold Garden Centre and motioned to object to it, as it was felt that the application would lead to a significant housing density increase on the site, and the application did not offer anything back to the village in terms of amenity. The Application at the Vintners site was also objected to by Councillors, with concerns about access to the site and a distortion to Waverley Borough Council's Spatial Strategy.

Councillors are also saddened to learn that UKOG have decided to appeal Surrey County Council's decision to refuse the application for experimental oil exploration at High Loxley. Alfold Parish Council have, as a result requested to join Waverley Borough Council as a Rule 6 party and have already submitted evidence.

Furthermore, Councillors discussed the news that Trinity College Cambridge had pulled out of Dunsfold Park. At present, there is no further information but Alfold Parish Councillors have requested discussions with Waverley and Rutland to understand what plans are going forward.

Alfold Parish Council are pleased to note that they have formally adopted the BT phone box at the Rosemary Lane junction with Loxwood Road and would be looking at undertaking repairs in order to make it weatherproof and waterproof. APC believe that it will be an important community asset and are looking forward to asking Alfold what it would like to do with the box – there are many options!

The Clerk also reported that she had been costing grit bins and salt for a number of locations in the village in order for villagers to salt their pavements when we incur colder weather. Villagers would be able to use of the salt in the bins to spread on footpaths and roads to prevent slippage and skidding and to ensure the increased safety of our residents. Updates will occur for the Dunsfold Road footpath in due course too.

As the weather improves, Alfold Parish Council would encourage garden bonfires to be lit in consideration to the neighbouring properties (continued on page I I)





## On Getting to Church at a Social Distance

#### My dear Nephew Darren

Since your parishioners mostly live in an area of half a square mile, where their only concern in getting to church is whether to take the underpass, or to risk a dash across the ring road, you may have little understanding of the problems our folk have in travelling our long country lanes to church, especially as we are keeping our social distance from each other.

Several parishioners have decided that they can't possibly share cars even with their own spouses, as in their 15-room homes they have successfully (and in some cases, happily) avoided each other for months. So the lane outside the church has filled up each week with Mercedes nudging Audis, and Land Rovers easing in between Bentleys.

Others arrive on horseback. But they are careless about leaving their horses to graze in the churchyard, and I have had to remind them twice that flowers in memorial vases are not fodder. The horses do help to keep the grass down, but unfortunately our verger now objects to standing outside during Matins, holding the reins of half a dozen horses. He says it is not part of his job description, which only confirms my view that there is entirely too much fuss these days about having job descriptions at all.

Major Crompton's devotion to his new sit-on lawnmower has inspired him to travel to church on it. Since he is unable to uncouple the mowing apparatus, the tarmac on his two-mile drive is acquiring interesting patterns. His drive at two miles per hour along narrow lanes means he arrives leading a procession of cars with drivers given the opportunity to exercise the Christian virtue of patience.

Mrs Pendleton, on the other hand, leads a small but select group from the Mothers' Union who are all keen cyclists. They all arrive on a whoosh of fresh air, their hair in total disarray, but with pink cheeks glowing with health. Nobody in church minds sitting near them, as anyone who can manage to peddle an old three-gear bicycle up the hill to our church is most unlikely to be sickening for anything.

Finally, of course, the majority arrive on foot, having negotiated fields, stiles and assorted cattle on the way. The countryside may well praise God, but one does wish they wouldn't bring quite so much of it into church.


