#### Dear Friends,

Fear not – your Cushing's Column will be back next time, but he has very generously allowed his (and your) new Curate to take over the welcome slot for this month's magazine.

There is so much to give thanks for over these past few months since we, as a family, landed in Alfold and Loxwood. I have seen more local wildlife recently than for many years; losing count of the number of pheasants, grouse and bats – despite growing up in the Warwickshire countryside surrounded by farms. I love looking up at the stars on cloudless nights, spotting the stunning beauty of the heavens combined with the darkness and quiet brings me a real sense of lasting peace.

What God has been nudging me in this season is how good it is to notice; to see and hear what is going on around. I have loved hearing stories from incredibly friendly and welcoming folk who have lived here for generations as a family. So often I heard: "we only came for two years ..." and this was now over 20 years ago! This love for the villages is so gratifying to see and shows the real heart people have for the area, and the connections they have readily built with the community at large. This was even more in evidence when seeing the very generous gifts brought together at our recent Harvest services, ready to support the local food banks. Thank you too for those Friends of St Nicholas who worked tirelessly recently to put on an incredible Flanders and Swan evening in October, to complement the Hog Roast the previous month.

I am also a real lifelong learner – and every week I love reflecting on what I have learnt that week – like how the mobile post office works in serving the surrounding villages; bringing services to those who would otherwise have none. I love walking around this area, especially along the reclaimed Wey and Arun canal towpath and being in awe of the decades of work done to rebuild the canal and offer it back for all. Being in the Onslow Arms meeting friends when it won its recent national pub award for best family pub was a really special evening, seeing Loxwood being put on the map nationally. One of my greatest life lessons was how to gently manoeuvre an escaped cow, that had found itself by our garden, back into the right field. Living on a farm, I love my conversations with the farmers and am slowly beginning to understand how hard they work in an industry that is incredibly difficult to keep going in.

#### **Mothers Union**

Our members were very blessed with a sunny day for the Annual Deanery Service 13th October 11am. This year St. Nicholas Alfold was chosen to be hosts.



The Holy Communion was presided by Revd. John Bundock, very well known to some members as he had led a group on a visit to the Holy Land and also Iona. After the Service Roger and Sharon Brockway gave us a very interesting talk about the history of this very old Church. A place of Christian worship for over 900years. Roger told us about the yew trees being planted maybe 2000years ago by Druids, so this ground has always had a spiritual connection. The yews were planted in a straight line between the villages of Alfold, Dunsfold and Hambledon!

13th Century records show the font to be 1080, the Nave and Chancel Norman 1080--1100. In the 12th century the south Isle was built, the north Isle in the 14th, the Spire and all the wonderful woodwork added 15th-16th century. Roger told us about the Jacobean pulpit complete with sounding box, I had always wondered why that top bit was there not just decoration. The Altar being topped by a slab of Sussex marble with fossils of freshwater mussels and winkles. The Bells which were restored in 1997 the oldest bell is 1625. The Church warden's chest complete with two keys one for each Church warden. The beautiful glass windows and family plaques, we are very Blessed to have this beautiful old Church to Worship.

We all enjoyed a delicious lunch together in the Church rooms, none of us being put in the stocks.

Our next meeting will be Wednesday 10th November at St, Nicolas Cranleigh. A social occasion sharing Lockdown Experiences. New members are always very welcome.

#### Cranleigh Lions Club - Project Wenceslas

Will you be nice and cosy in your home this winter? How would you feel about helping those that won't be?

Some people have to choose between heating and eating – this year the situation could be worse with energy bills going up and furlough coming to an end.

Please consider helping Cranleigh Lions to help others by taking part in Project Wenceslas and donating some or, perhaps, all of your Winter Fuel Payment to us.

The Winter Fuel Payment is paid to those born on or before 26<sup>th</sup> September 1955 and those living in the UK for at least one day during the week of 20<sup>th</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> September 2021 – this is called the "Qualifying Week".

This payment is not means tested, it is tax free and will not affect other benefits.

The payment is £200, or £100 each for a couple, and increased to £300 for those born on or before 26<sup>th</sup> September 1941.

If you are eligible you will usually get the payment automatically. Most payments are made in November and December. You may need to claim it if you have not had it before or if certain conditions apply – details at www.gov.uk. You have until 31st March 2022 to claim for winter 2021-2022.

Cranleigh Lions are asking that if you do not need this money you donate your Winter Fuel Payment, or some of it, to the Cranleigh Lions' Wenceslas Project.

Working in conjunction with the Citizens Advice Bureau, Barnados, the Housing Department at Waverley Borough Council, local churches and other organisations funds will be used to help local people whose fuel bills are causing them problems.

Money is not given to individuals – we make payment direct to energy companies or we top pre-payment cards up with cash.

If you would like to help those who are unable to keep warm this winter please consider donating your Winter Fuel Payment or some of it to Cranleigh Lions.



#### THAKEHAM HOMES PARTNER WITH STONEWATER

Residents should be aware that Thakeham Homes have now partnered with an Affordable Homes provider, Stonewater, for the development of the site west of Pond Copse Lane Loxwood. The original approved application was for a development of 50 houses of which 35 would be market value houses for sale and 15 Affordable houses in a mix agreed with CDC in an \$106 Agreement.

The situation according to the Stonewater Press Release (see below) indicates that now all 50 houses will be classified as affordable in a mix of 30 flats/houses for rent, 7 houses rent to buy and 13 shared ownership. Works have already commenced on site, contrary to a planning condition that no works should commence until an agreed waste and surface water disposal plan had been agreed with Southern Water and that such works had been carried out in accordance with that plan.Loxwood Parish Council has taken up this breach of planning condition with CDC and is awaiting a response.

Chichester confirms that they only require 15 of the houses to be affordable and not 50. The Parish Council is concerned that there is a lack of Local Need for so many affordable homes, given the other developments that have recently taken place. However, the proposers, Stonewater, state "they are delighted" "to deliver **desperately** needed affordable homes for **local** people in the small rural village of Loxwood" \*. Watch this space for further developments

## Wey and Arun Canal Trust adds a Wheelyboat to its fleet

Wey & Arun Canal Trust members gathered last week to welcome the latest addition to the charity's fleet: a Mk III Wheelyboat.



The boat was officially named the *Walter Grove* at a special ceremony in Loxwood on Saturday 23rd October. The purchase of the second-hand Mk III Wheelyboat was made possible by a generous donation from supporter Peter Grove and has been named in memory of his grandfather, who was a master carpenter on the Wey Navigation from 1885 to 1930. Peter, who now lives in the US, was represented at the ceremony by his cousin lan Hair, from Alfold, who christened the boat on his behalf.

The multipurpose 17.5ft long wheelchair-accessible boat can easily be moved using the Trust's own equipment and will give the Trust more options to operate boat trips for small groups and on less accessible sections of the canal. The new boat will be ideal for the Summit Level, near Cranleigh and Dunsfold, where there are no canal locks.

Wey & Arun Canal Trust chairman Sally Schupke said: "Over the next few years it is clear that we will be offering boat trips in different parts of the canal. The versatility that this boat offers is something we were looking for."

The boat has moveable seating to allow up to seven passengers or five wheelchair users to be accommodated in comfort and was supplied and refurbished by The Wheelyboat Trust, a national charity dedicated to getting thousands of wheelchair users out enjoying the UK's inland waterways.

The Wheelyboat Trust Director Andy Beadsley said the benefits of getting disabled people out on the waterways were huge. "There are lots of health and wellbeing advantages to being out in the open air and on the water. We've worked with many disability groups, SEN schools and charities and we're delighted to be able to work with the Wey & Arun Canal Trust. We hope lots of wheelchair users in Surrey and beyond will be able to enjoy life on the canal as much as their able-bodied counterparts, thanks to the new Wheelyboat."

Seating and bimini canopy and electric outboard, battery and charger for the Wheelyboat have been generously provided by the Ernest Kleinwort Charitable Trust and Henry Smith Charity respectively. The Trust hopes to offer boat trips in 2022 once skipper training has been completed.

The Walter Grove joins the Trust's other trip boats, the 27-seat Zachariah Keppel and the 52-seat electric Wiggonholt, which also boasts an access lift. Boat cruises have been running throughout the year on the Wey & Arun Canal and volunteers are now preparing for the popular Santa Cruises, with tickets on sale now.



written it on lined notepaper in capital letters, preferably in green ink, to make it look truly authentic) saying that you had seen the archdeacon do it, and then you had watched him drive off without stopping. That would have taken the minds of the senior clergy away from parish matters for quite some time.

No, never worry about the wrath of bishops; dangers lurk much nearer home. For a start, never incur the displeasure of your flower arrangers. I only crossed their path once – and arrived in church the following Sunday, to see a ten-foot-high floral arrangement at the front of church. I assumed it was by way of making amends, until I discovered it had been placed in front of the pulpit. I was obliged to preach, hidden behind a large multicoloured hedge, while the congregation listened to what were apparently talking chrysanthemums.

A colleague offended his own ladies and arrived to find that the contents of the safe had been removed and replaced with all those exotic pieces of equipment that seem to be indispensable for arranging flowers. He was obliged to administer Communion using a small vase until peace was reestablished and his chalice returned to him.

Similarly, organists are a delicate breed. Congratulate him on the anthem, and if it happened to be unaccompanied, he would assume you were implying that the services were better without his playing. Offend your organist and you can be guaranteed that hymns will be played at either half or double speed, stopping one verse short and that the final piece of music as you process out will stop, leaving you and the choir stranded halfway down the aisle.

And finally, never, ever upset your verger. One forgotten Christmas present and you can be sure you will get half-way through a baptism to find he hasn't put water in the font; at marriage services, the sheets for last week's funeral will have been accidentally put out and when you sit in your stall you will discover where he now stores the mop and bucket.

No, bishops are warm, fluffy bunnies; real dangers lurk much nearer home. Your loving uncle,


